4-1-1. Established.

There is hereby established an ambulance service for the residents of the City, to be operated by the City Fire Department for the express purpose of transporting injured, ill or any other person in any emergency condition to local hospitals.

4-1-2. Establishment of rates.

The rates to be charged by the ambulance service shall be established by resolution for residents of the City and also for nonresidents of the City, if any.

4-1-3. Adoption of regulations, procedures.

The City Council shall by resolution establish such rules, regulations and operating procedures for the ambulance service as it deems appropriate.

4-1-4. Support with tax revenues.

The operational expenses for the ambulance service shall be defrayed by tax revenues and shall be an appropriate item in the City budget which is adopted annually by the City Council.

4-1-5. Voluntary contributions.

There shall be nothing in this chapter which will preclude receiving voluntary contributions from City residents and others for the purchase and operation of ambulance vehicles and services.
